Te Raekaihau Restoration Group (TRiG) invites you to their tree planting afternoon on

Saturday, 23 May 2 - 5 pm

at the Te Raekaihau Headland Park. Come and enjoy the first Houghton Valley planting for the season and help fill an empty forest understorey with living green!

WHAT TO BRING

Bring a spade if you have one, gloves, sturdy footwear and clothing appropriate for the weather. Your children are welcome but please take care with them along the tracks and when planting.

HOW TO GET THERE

At the crest of Hungerford Road where it meets View Road, View Road South heads up to the south-west (it looks like a drive). At the end there is a letterbox with 113 on it. Take the lower, smaller track (Kae Miller Track) and follow the signs to Ruru Track.

Parking in View Road South is limited, so carpool with friends, come on foot, by bus (No. 23, Houghton Bay-Mairangi) park down on View Road, or on Houghton Bay Road.



In the event of heavy rain, storm etc, the date will move to 6th June, however the site is sheltered and planting may go ahead even if the weather seems bad. For further information or confirmation of planting please phone ...
