Kia ora,

This leaflet is to let you know about a change we are proposing to make in your neighbourhood.

## Proposal:

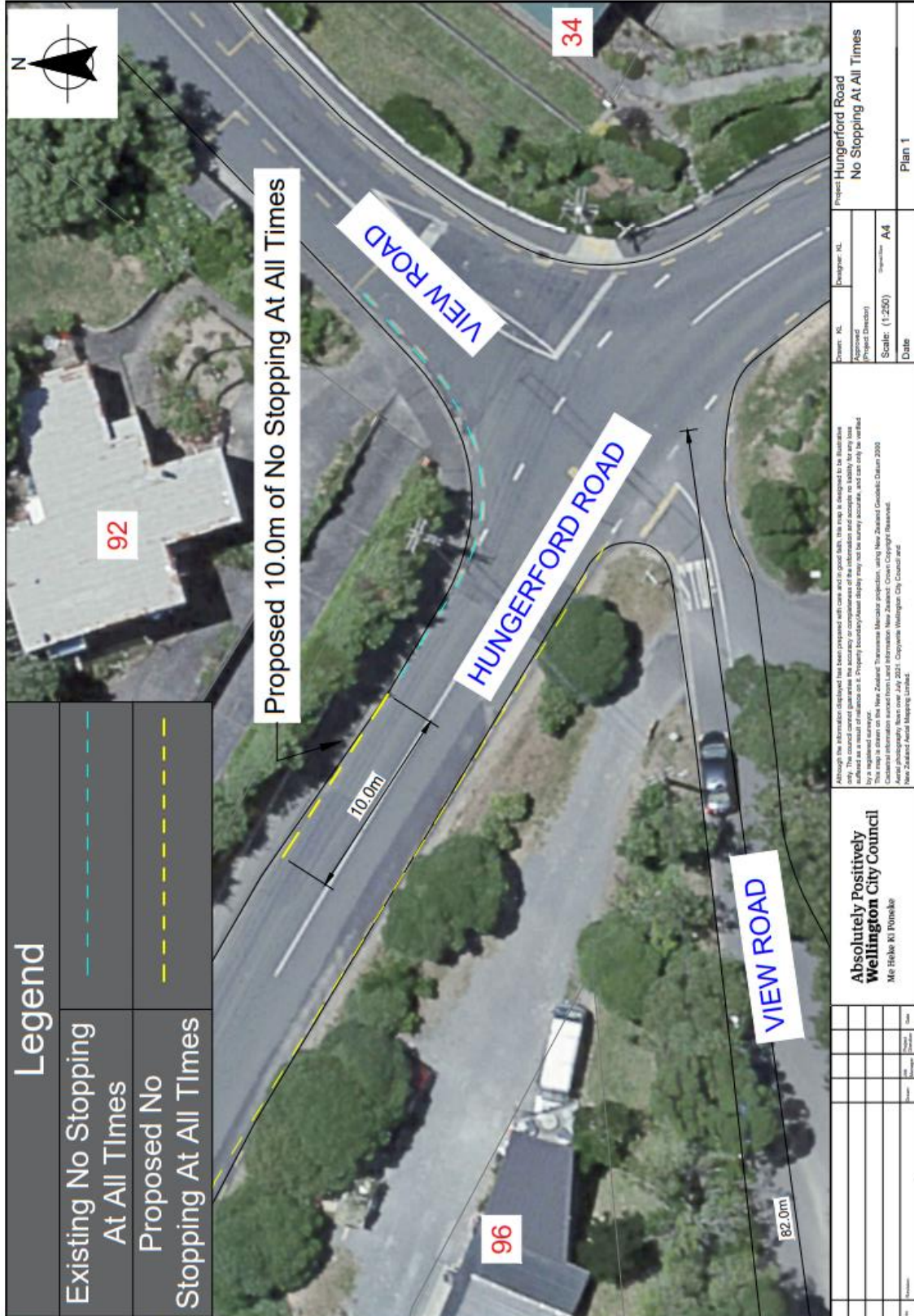
<b>Reference</b>	TR136-23 Hungerford Road, Houghton Bay – No Stopping At All Times
<b>Location – where we propose to make the change</b>	Hungerford Road, approximately 20 metres from the intersection with View Road (corner with no.92 View Road)
<b>What we'd like to do</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Install No Stopping At All Times</li> </ul>
<b>Why we are proposing the change</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wellington City Council (WCC) received safety concerns from a local resident about cars parking near the intersection of Hungerford Road with View Road outside no.92 View Road.</li> <li>• There is limited visibility at this section of road of oncoming traffic from either direction because of the crest in the carriageway. Cars parking outside no.92 View Road force drivers to cross the centre line onto the opposing traffic, creating safety concerns due to this limited forward visibility.</li> <li>• To improve safety and reduce crashes associated with the lack of forward visibility our engineering team is proposing to extend by 10m the length of No Stopping At All Times.</li> </ul>
<b>Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Improves intersection safety</li> <li>• Reduces crash likelihood</li> <li>• Net parking impact – removal of two unrestricted parking spaces</li> <li>• Pedestrian impact – no change to pedestrian facilities</li> </ul>
<b>How this relates to the parking policy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support safe movement – facilitate the safe and efficient movement of people and goods by focusing on people moving along transport corridors rather than people parking or storing stationary vehicles.</li> </ul>
